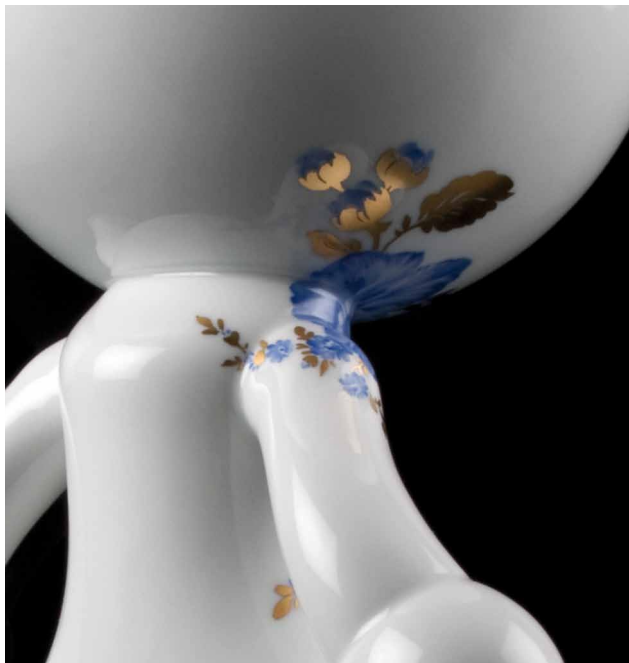


+EYE® WHITE KNIGHT

Porcelain is revered by connoisseurs as „white gold“. This passion was also shared by Frederick the Great. The Prussian king was especially fond of the decor “Bleu Mourant” meaning dying blue, created in 1784. He had a predilection for this delicate matt blue, which also set the tone in his private apartments in the Sanssouci palace of Potsdam. Each +EYE[®] White Knight is individually hand painted in Berlin. It expresses Prussian elegance in a contemporary context.
